

Appleton is a unique community. We are generous, visionary and driven, continually moving forward and upward. Appleton Public Library's history is reflective of its citizens investing in literacy, learning, empowerment and progress.



Appleton Public Library is an essential resource in times of crisis

During times of crisis, communities rely on their libraries as an essential resource. For example, through the COVID-19 pandemic our library quickly adapted to provide curbside pickup of materials and online programming. When the Great Recession hit in 2009, Appleton Public Library experienced record visits and checkouts. The library door count topped over 3,300 visits on a summer day during that period.

These recent events illustrate how Appleton Public library is the key to community resilience. It offered connection and diversion during the darkest days of lockdown. And it provided valuable tools and resources to help our community get back on its feet after a severe economic downturn. Appleton Public Library is there for our community when it needs it most.



why now?

The library has been an important part of our educational, social and economic infrastructure for 125 years, continually adjusting and growing to meet the needs of our community. It is time to upgrade and expand our building to meet our current and future needs.

THE EXISTING BUILDING IS DEFICIENT IN THE FOLLOWING WAYS:

- It is outdated and unable to meet the functions required of a larger, more technologically savvy population.
- It doesn't support inviting, flexible and supportive learning environments for children and teens.
- Meeting space is inadequate and insufficient for the growing demand.
- Technology infrastructure no longer supports digital learning and skills development.
- HVAC system, lighting and noise-mitigation systems are inadequate and its back-office operations are inefficient.

The current library building simply does not permit the library staff to serve the Appleton community to its full potential. In the 40+ years since the current building opened in 1981, Appleton has increased in size from 58,000 to 76,000 in 2020. Population growth for the City is expected to increase by 9.4% by 2040. We need to address the present inadequacies of the building and also plan for future growth.

Appleton Public Library as a community catalyst

The vision for the College Avenue North neighborhood redevelopment plan includes Appleton Public Library as an anchor. This library development project becomes the nucleus to redefine this neighborhood. By investing in the library at its current location, the City puts a stake in the ground, with a new vision for this area as a cultural, economic and residential center.

The plan to re-use the current building is the most responsible and sustainable way to utilize our community resources and keep the library in the heart of the city. This plan sets an example of good stewardship and responsible development.

The City of Appleton has engaged the award-winning architectural firm Skidmore, Owings & Merrill (SOM)

to design the library renovation. SOM is recognized as a leader in library design; highly skilled in building re-use, equity and inclusion, sustainability, technology, operational efficiency, and other key factors necessary for a successful public library project.

The library design provides 90,150 square feet of beautiful, transformational space – adding 4,150 square feet filled with natural light and sustainable systems and materials.

notable spaces

THE COMMONS

- Functions as town square
- Staircase connects to upper level
- Welcoming entrance, open and light-filled

COMMUNITY MEETING ROOM

- For public meetings, film series, concerts, lectures, etc.
- Can host up to 315 people and after-hours access
- 3,100 sq. ft. multi-use space can be divided into 1-3 rooms
- Soaring windows bring in nature and extend the library outward

LEARNING STAIRS

- Ideal spot for school field trips, impromptu meetings and scheduled performances
- Serves as physical transition space to the children's department where everything is designed to inspire wonder and curiosity
- Light-filled and prominent space to engage patrons entering building

FLEXBOX

- Demonstration and hands-on learning space
- Access to new kinds of technology typically not available for free
- Fosters new ideas, hobbies and passions and offers opportunities to share them

CO-WORKING SPACE

- Hub for employment and business development, entrepreneurship
- Support small businesses, entrepreneurs and start-ups
- Host networking events and computer support


THE BLUFF

- Placed strategically under the main skylight in the Children's Area, this light-filled space will invite families to spend extended time at the library
- Features a climbing hill that invites exploration and play for children of all ages
- Host a variety of activities throughout the day















A public-private partnership to leverage the community's resources

Appleton has a history of launching successful public-private partnerships to provide valuable resources for our community. This project presents the next opportunity for historic investment in the community's future.

The cost for this building project is currently estimated at \$40.4 million. The City of Appleton has committed \$26.4 million for project costs spread across three years, with an additional \$2 million from the Federal American Rescue Plan Act. The *Building Beyond Words* Campaign goal is to provide \$12 million to ensure this library has the needed features and enhancements to serve and advance the community.
